Women's participation in a biological environmental revolution: In accordance with the existing census, in Iran women are more responsible for house management. Since most of the municipal wastes are generated in houses, indisputably women's collaboration in relation to garbage recycling will be suitable strategies for the purpose of environment preservation and generating less slag. Based on this, management sector of municipal slag, using its experts, took some steps to instruct the families in different stages. According to the world technology, the more participate the instructions are, the more suitable they'll be to people. Since children are pioneers in learning what is taught giving instructions at school was among the primary actions. Concurrent with this instructing sanitation department mediators, that is instructing women who supervise some families started. At last, when all the families were almost ready to receive the complete instructions, the experts for separating the slag using the provided brochures started to instruct the housekeepers in a face-to-face manner. Since in this sort of instruction, the learner is situated in a face-to-face position to receive the instructions from the instructor, she can ask any questions and instructions which will stick in her mind once answered. Using the above-mentioned instructions, the families accepted the slag separation easily and handed their slag to those in charge of collecting the garbage in a separated manner in 3 forms: organic, non-recyclable and dry recyclable. So they prevented the burial of slag, cutting the trees importing the raw materials for producing plastics and etc. Housekeepers came to this conclusion that due to categorizing plastics in group of non-recyclable substances, they must use them in a less volume as much as it is possible. So that they didn't use the garbage plastic bags in their dustbins.
